ART ADVICE

Make it colorful! Top selections will be on display to the public, so make it appealing. Fill up the whole page. Feel free to write a slogan on the picture about what being kind to Animals means to you. Be Sure to Follow the Exhibiting Rules! We are unable to make exceptions.

EXHIBITION

All students will be notified by mail of the top selections chosen. Top Selections will be on display in the Adoption Area from April 13th, 2009 to May 4th, 2009. Artwork can be claimed by coming to the Humane Society during the month of June. Return of entries cannot be guaranteed because of so many participants.

AWARDS

Everyone is a winner! Each entry will receive a Certificate of Recognition. The top selections will receive ribbons. Judges will select 1st, 2nd, and 3rd places in each age category based on message, originality, and creativity. These top selections will receive a special award.

AWARDS CEREMONY

Top artist selections and their families and teachers will be invited by mail to the Awards Ceremony at the Humane Society of Hall County on Sunday May 2, 2009.

1. ARTWORK SIZE

Artwork Must be 8 1/2" x 11", or 11" x 14", on white or buff paper. Pictures should not be mounted or framed. Paper this size can be found in most art supply stores.

2. MEDIA

Crayon, pencil, watercolor, tempera, acrylic, magic marker, colored pencil, and chalk.

3. AGE CATEGORIES

Category I- Kindergarten- Grade 2

Category II- Grades 3-6

Category III- Grades 7-9

Category IV- Grades 10-12

Entries may be submitted by individuals or by schools. One entry per artist and one artist per entry.

4. THEME

Artwork should reflect the "BE KIND TO ANIMALS" theme. Consider topics like pet adoptions, pet care, pet overpopulation, concern for wildlife, and endangered species, the unwanted pet problem, obeying animal laws, careers in animal work, adopting homeless pets, respect for animals nobody loves, pet therapy, concern for animals in entertainment, etc. Be creative, and we would like further ideas! Please, no copying work. Teachers are welcome to call the HSHC for pickup of artwork by a classroom or grade.

5. IDENTIFICATION

All artwork MUST have a completed entry form attached to the Back. Use the entry form on the back. Please photocopy as many as you need. Be sure to fill it out completely and legibly. Secure the entry form to the artwork by taping it to the lower left hand corner of the BACK of the artwork, DO NOT STAPLE OR GLUE THE ENTRY.

6. DEADLINE: MARCH 31, 2009

Bring or mail your artwork to the Humane Society of Hall County at 845 West Ridge Road, Gainesville, GA 30501. You may deliver the entries Monday-Saturday 10am-5pm and Sunday 1pm-5pm
